

Aylburton Flower and Vegetable Show 2016

Rules

All exhibits must have been produced by the exhibitor or have been in their possession two months prior to the Show.

The Hall will be opened from 9 - 11am on the day of the Show for the staging of exhibits.

All exhibitors must leave the Hall by 11am.

No late entries accepted.

All entries are charged at 25p with the exception of the junior classes which are free.

Any objections to the decision of the Judges must be made in writing and delivered to the Show Secretary before 3pm on the day of the show. Any prize will be withheld until a decision is reached.

The exhibit must contain the exact number of specimens specified in the schedule, or it will be disqualified.

All vegetables, where practical, must be exhibited on plates. Cut flowers must be in vases. Vegetables must be trimmed before entering the Hall.

The committee reserves the right to visit any garden.

No entry may be removed before 4pm.

Children's/Junior awards and prizes will be presented at the Hall at 1pm on the day of the show.

All other cups and trophies will be presented at The Cross Inn at 7pm on the evening of show day.

All adult entries will be auctioned after prize giving.

ALL exhibits to this show excluding pot plant entries are considered donated to the auction.
